



Tasting #1 – Highland Park "Angels Delight" Orkney Island, Bottle 4.223

Colour: Rich Gold

Nose: Heather moor-burn and burnt sticks, with toffee, caramel and meringue sweetness, dulce sherry and toasted macaroons.

Palate: A classic combination of subtle smoke and burnt leaves, with rich honey, dark chocolate, sweet sherry and muscovado: dry oak tannins and spices tingle the mouth.

Diluted Nose: We now have spun sugar, vanillas and prunes, bonfire embers and enough ware house aromas to delight a host of Angels.

Diluted Palate: Chocolate raisins and syrup sponge, with a blanket-stitch of smoke all arounf the tongue.

Comments: Twenty years in an ex-bourbon hogshead followed by a 1st fill Pedro Ximenez cask make for this special Highland Park.

Tasting #2 – Bowmore "Hebredian Dreams" Island of Islay, Bottle 3.294

Colour: Corn Marigold

Palate: We were transported on to the deck of a coal fired steam puffer feeling the cold salty sea breeze across our faces and warming our hands on a mug of Gaelic coffee or mulled wine spiced with cinnamon and cloves. Lunch was served and we enjoyed griddled scallops with smoked, sweet chilli sauce and smoked salmon crabmeat salad.

Diluted: With a drop of water we went ashore on a now beautiful **sunny late afternoon** at a sandy beach on the western shores of the Outer Hebrides with the **machair in full bloom** and watched the sunset with **sweet**, **slightly smoky**, **creamy lavender lobster bisque**.

Drinking tip: Desert island dram

Cask: Refill hogshead

Bowmore – Islay

Rare: USA allocation: 120 bottles

Age: 20 years

Date distilled: April 1996 ABV: 56.5%

Tasting #3 – Premium Vault Port Ellen – 9th Edition 30 Years \$ 20/ dram

Nose: Rich and rounded on the nose with soft pear fruit over a driftwood bonfire, then sandy notes, fresh shellfish and samphire.

Palate: Firm bodied the palate is surprising sweet at first, then the smoke dominates, but the character always remains pure Port Ellen.

Diluted: Adding water brings up extra virgin olive oil and produces a fine soft texture on the palate.

Comments: This distillery was <u>closed</u> four years after this malt was made.

Age: 30 years

Tasting #4 – Talisker - 25 Year Old

Nose: Mellow, juicy and ever changing the nose shows sweetness with a trace of smoke, then opens out to heathery peat, with waves of fresh baked apple cake and finally of the ocean itself rolling in behind.

Palate: Medium bodied, rich and silky smooth, this sweet starting malt drinks well at natural strength. The sweetness is followed by the trademark Talisker pepperiness.

Diluted: With water orange peel notes emerge followed by more maritime characteristics.

Comments: The long peppery finish is reassuringly warming.
