



Tasting #1 – Springbank "Too Cool for School"

Colour: Golden Amber

Nose/ Palate et al: Ginger nuts in creamy latte with mint chocolate genache, old leather books and waxed church pews, and a puff of hickory smoke. Toasted marshmallow and peppered tuna steak. Ginger snap baskets with red berries. Salted French fries and chocolate milk shake.

Finish: It's just Too Cool for School!

Tasting #2 – Bladnoch – "Complex and Lively"

Colour: Amber

Nose: The nose has toffee apples, marzipan and Daim bars, stewed plums, cherry brandy, driedflowers and linseed oil.

Palate: The pallet gives moffat toffees, candy necklaces, Coco Pops and cappuccino and deeper notes of leather, rubber and carmelized oinions.

Finish: Complex and Lively.

Note: Another rare offering from the smallest Scotch producer there is.

Bladnoch – Western Lowlands Extremely Rare : 2 of only 121 Worldwide

Tasting # 3 Premium Vault - \$10/ dram 30Year Old Teaninich

Colour: Honey Gold

Nose: A sensory journey from an old wine cellar to a muggy pine forest; porridge oaks, bonfire smoke, textiles and lipstick sweetness

Palate: On the palate some oomph of peat, pecan nuts and Bavarian smokes ham (unctious).

Reduced Nose: Diluting brings you to an old cottage with stewed apples.

Finish: Ashy and Spicy to the finish . . . A magnificent dram !

Teaninich – *Western* Highlands 30 Year Old Single Cask

Extremely Rare: 2 of only 58 released to the US

Proof: 102.4° \$10/ Dram



Tasting #4 – Isle of Jura " A couple of Classic Icons"

Colour: Warm golden color.

Nose: On the nose neat flamed grilled crisps and darkJamaican gingerbread.

Palate: Big and spicy like a classic Bloody Mary cocktail.

Diluted: A traditional Waldorf salad and the taste as sweet and refreshing as ice cold

sugar cane juice.

Finish: A Classic!

Rich Howard Tasting Room Notes

2. Isle of Jura Diurach 16 Year Old

Nose: Honeyed base with fudge and caramel. A few hints of mixed berries and chocolate. Subtle coastal notes and a clear note of pine trees and resin. Sweet (caramel) and sour (citrus) combination.

Palate: Really sweet, very caramelly. Butter pastry. Vanilla custard. Maple syrup. It returns nicely to spiced oak and Mexican chocolate. Subtle clove.

Finish: Hesitating between the milk chocolate sweetness and drying oak.

1. Isle of Jura - Superstition

Nose: Initial gristy cereal, gives way to evocative smoke and heady malt. It's quite sweet and creamy, and reminds us of Chantilly cream.

Palate: Sweet and porridge-like. A cereal fest on the tongue, with hints of white pepper and black forest honey with hot buttered toast. Light and oily.

Finish: Medium length with cocoa and rice paper with hints of honey and spice on the tail. 43% ABV

3. Isle of Jura 26 Year Old – 26 Year Old Single Cask

Nose: On the nose neat flamed grilled crisps and darkJamaican gingerbread

Palate: Big and spicy like a classic Bloody Mary cocktail

Diluted: A traditional Waldorf salad and the taste as sweet and refreshing as ice cold sugar cane juice
