



Tasting #1 – Glenrothes "A Tuscan Landscape"

Colour: Amber Gold

Nose: The nose wafts creamy exotic fruits, maple syrup, sticky toffee pudding and

perfumed wood.

Palate: The palates fruitiness is bittersweet, with buttery textures (Lemon drizzle

cake) dried fruits melon, baked apple and hints of a cigar.

Diluted Nose: It becomes more citric and floral (evoking Tuscany).

Diluted Palate: Water produces more of the floral and accents the sweetness.

Comments: Complex fruit and flowers.

Tasting #2 Clynelish "Galactic Root Canal Treatment"

Colour: Light Gold

Nose: The nose shifts from white pepper, pine and varnish to lemon candles

liquorice, sherbet and old fashion racksacks.

Palate: The taste is chili hot and fierce.

Diluted Nose: Water brings out milk bottle sweets and laundry

Diluted Palate: A drop of water and it's sweeter with Haribos lemon barley water and

popcorn.

Finish: Some sweetness but long and peppery.

Color: Burnished Gold

Nose.: Full bodied sweetness with vanilla, butterscotch and Christmas pudding with Brandy sauce.

Palate: It is smooth and creamy on the palate with vanilla, cinder toffee and dark chocolate giving remarkable depth of character.

Finish: Long and satisfying with a dry oaky aftertaste.

Colour: Amber

spice. **ABV:** 43%

2. Macallan 15 Year Old, Fine Wood

Colour: Rich straw

Nose: Sublime and full with a hint of rose and cinnamon. **Palate:** Intense rich chocolate with a hint of orange and raisin. **Finish:** Lingering with a hint of chocolate, orange and dried

Proof: 112.2°

fruits. **ABV:** 43%
