



Tasting #1 – Glenburgie "Rose petal baths in Glasgow School of Art"

Colour: Amber Gold

Nose: The nose has Canvas, Easels, pastel, watercolors and brushes besides rose petals and Elderflower jelly and raspberries.

Palate: Smooth to the taste. The palate has a kind and soft rosewater-flavored

Turkish Delight.

Diluted: Water produces a leather armchair to relax into and to enjoy the spectacular intense aromas.

Comments: Complex fruit and flowers.

Tasting #2 Laphroaig "You gotta love this one"

Colour: Deep Amber

Nose: Peat smoke emerging from the pagoda and a beach barbecue with

langoustines, scallops and crispy aromatic duck.

Palate: The taste brings forward the beach and sea air with a delightful peat smoke

finish

Diluted: A drop of water and it becomes like a comfort blanket with flavors of tropical

fruit salad and clean peat smoke.

Finish: Sea air, fruit and a sweet peat smokiness.

Laphroaig – Islay Rare: 2 bottles of only 275 Released Worldwide

Tasting #3 Springbank "Cowboys Delight"

Colour: Old Brass

Nose: A polished leather saddle, then marinated pork and a hint of dry tar and burnt

toast.

Palate: The taste is sweet then savory with an unctuous charred pork crackling.

Diluted: This becomes a gammon grill, when qualified with water, with singed

pineapple and olive oil.

Finish: Unctuous, long and flavorful.

1. Springbank 10 Year Old

Our 10-year-old offers whisky drinkers the perfect introduction to the Springbank range. Matured in a combination of bourbon and sherry casks, it is perfectly balanced from the first sip through to the full, rich finish.

•Nose: Orchard fruit (pear) with a hint of peat, vanilla and malt

•Palate: Malt, oak, spice, nutmeg and cinnamon, vanilla

essence

•Finish: Sweet, with a lingering salty tingle ABV: 46%

2. SPRINGBANK 15 YEAR OLD

Like a storm gathering off the Kintyre coast, our 15-year-old Springbank is dark and ominous, yet delicious. Best enjoyed after dinner or with your favourite cigar, this is a true classic.

•Nose: Demerara sugar, dark chocolate, Christmas cake, almonds, toffee, oak

•Palate: Creamy, raisins, dark chocolate, figs, marzipan, brazil nuts and vanilla

•Finish: Oak and sherry notes sustain and mingle with hints of leather ABV: 46%

3. SOCIETY BOTTLE 27.104, SPRINGBANK 15 YEAR - COWBOYS DELIGHT

Colour: Old Brass

• Nose: A polished leather saddle, then marinated pork and a hint of dry tar and burnt toast.

Palate: The taste is sweet then savory with an unctuous charred pork crackling.

• Diluted: This becomes a gammon grill, when qualified with water, with singed pineapple and olive oil.

Finish: Unctuous, long and flavorful.

Tasting #4 – 1963 Strathisla "Gordon and MacPhail Bottling"

Color: Dark Amber

Nose.: Initially a delicate fresh edge. Stewed fruity notes (raisins and apples) and a rich

sweetness develops

Palate: Mouth warming and creamy with a burst of chilli spices. Some dark chocolate notes

emerge with a touch of aged leather.

Diluted Nose: Defined estery notes, fresh, fragrant and floral notes (rose petals). A hint of

ground coffee beans develops and a sweet fudge element.

Palate with Water: Sweet with a subtle hint of spices. Mouth warming, very smooth and

pleasant.

Finish: Full bodied, a fine example of an after dinner dram.
