Bowmore 11 Year – Single Cask from Montgomerie

Bowmore 20 Year, Society private bottling – 2 of only 216 released WW.



#1 - Bladnoch - Lowlands 25 Year Old, Bottle # 50.80, 'Quality Time'

Colour: Toffee Penny Wrapper

Nose: Magic balloons burst into a fireworks of flowers, which fell to the earth in a eucalyptus forest. This was followed by lime cordial, sultanas and dark chocolate orange.

Palate: The taste was an explosion of syrupy fruits (cherry, orange) and various fruity

sweets, some dark chocolate, interesting chili spice, plus polished furniture.

Diluted Nose: Fruits were more obvious, rhubarb, papaya, dragon fruit, and mandarin – someone got an old fashioned post office (sweet, newspaper, stationary, etc.).

Diluted Palate: We now found sugar coated fennel seeds, ginger Edinburgh rock, lychee

and lemonade..

Comments: Inspirational sweetness.

Tasting #2 – Highland Park 16 Year Old, Cask # 4.218 'A Little Warmth'

Colour: Glowing Brass Trumpet

Nose: The initial nose was embers, aromatic charred wood, freshly brewed nettle tea and blackberry compote.

Palate: The taste was herbal, salty, dry and quite some heat all in perfect balance with flavours of roasted chestnuts and dry cured black forest ham..

Diluted Nose: Water brought out more sweetness like roasting marshmallows or caramelizing crème brulee.

Diluted Palate: The palate was soft and sweet, a peach melba with pistachio and almond caramel cream.

Comments: When in need of a little warmth.

Tasting #3 – 1973 Craigduff Premium Vault \$20.00/ Dram

A 1973 vintage whisky bottled under the Craigduff label. The spirit was produced at Strathisla distillery and was peated, unlike their regular releases, hence the alternative name. There's not much of it around, but Signatory have yet again dug up a cask - distilled on 4 April 1973, matured for 40 years (to the day) in a refill butt and bottled on 4 April 2013 at cask strength.

Comments: Can't find this anywhere.

#4 – Bowmore - Islay 20 Year Old, Bottle # 3.274, 'Crab Sticks and Foam Shrimps'

Colour: Neptune's Trident

Nose: The nose brought you sea air, shellfish, seaweed and peat.

Palate: The taste was warm jam on salty crackers, crab sticks and foam shrimps followed by green tea. Later there was roast cod with tabasco, monkfish wrapped in pancetta and key lime pie. It finished with prawn crackers and roasted seasoned seaweed with some raspberry cranachan.

Comments: The aroma of sea air, spices and peat, in a tent in the rain.
